



Live Captioning

Live Captioning - What is it?

- <u>Live captioning</u> describes both machine-generated and human-transcribed text provided in real time.
- Made available to the audience through a CC button within a video player or via a separate browser window.


Live Captioning - when?

- 1. Accommodations for any event
- 2. Public events
- 3. Internal facing (VT-only) public events



Live Captioning - How?

- Professional live captions requestable service
 - ~\$1/min (centralized & non-centralized)
- Machine (AI) captions (e.g. webcaptioner.com)
 - Free service, less accurate


