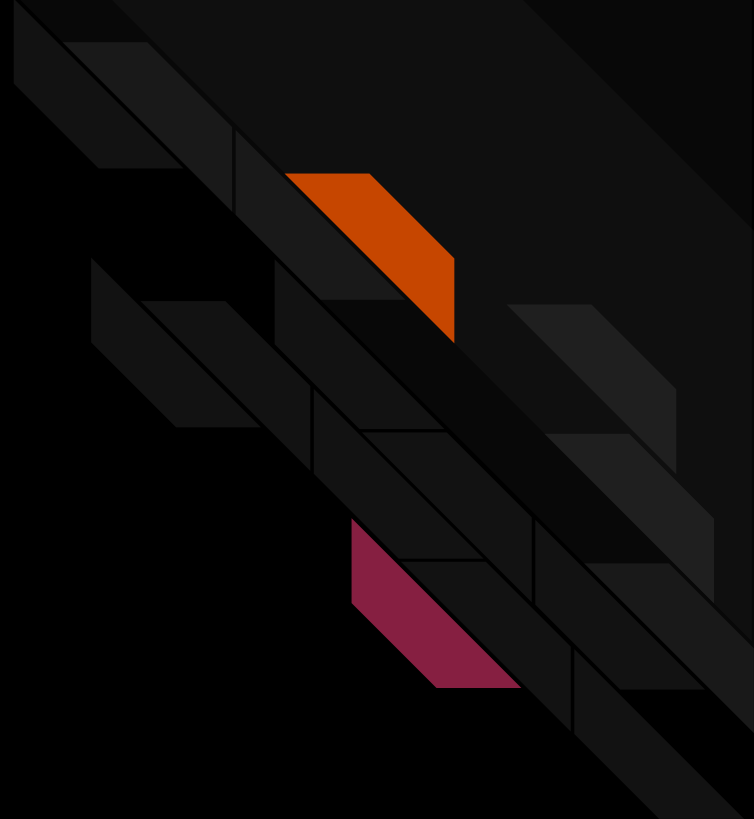

- Cooperative Extension (by approval)

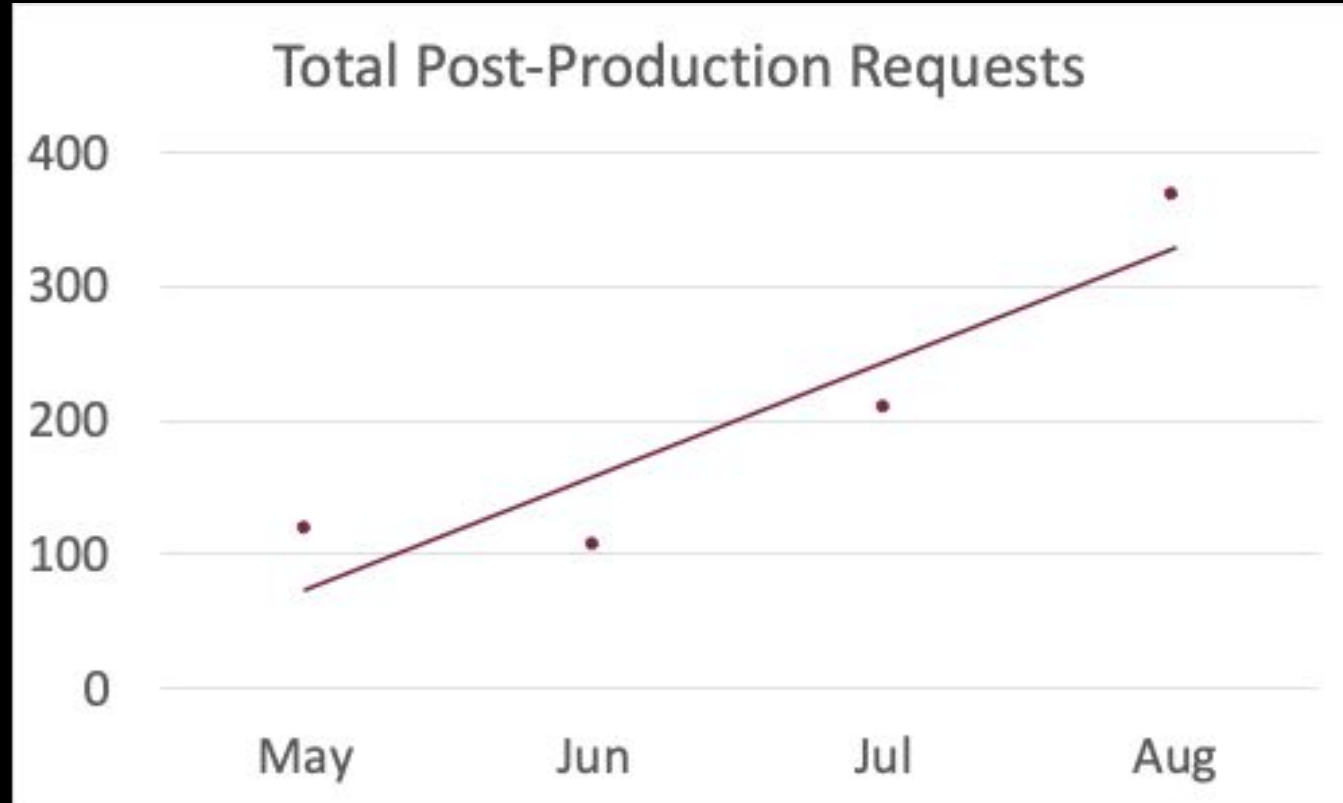

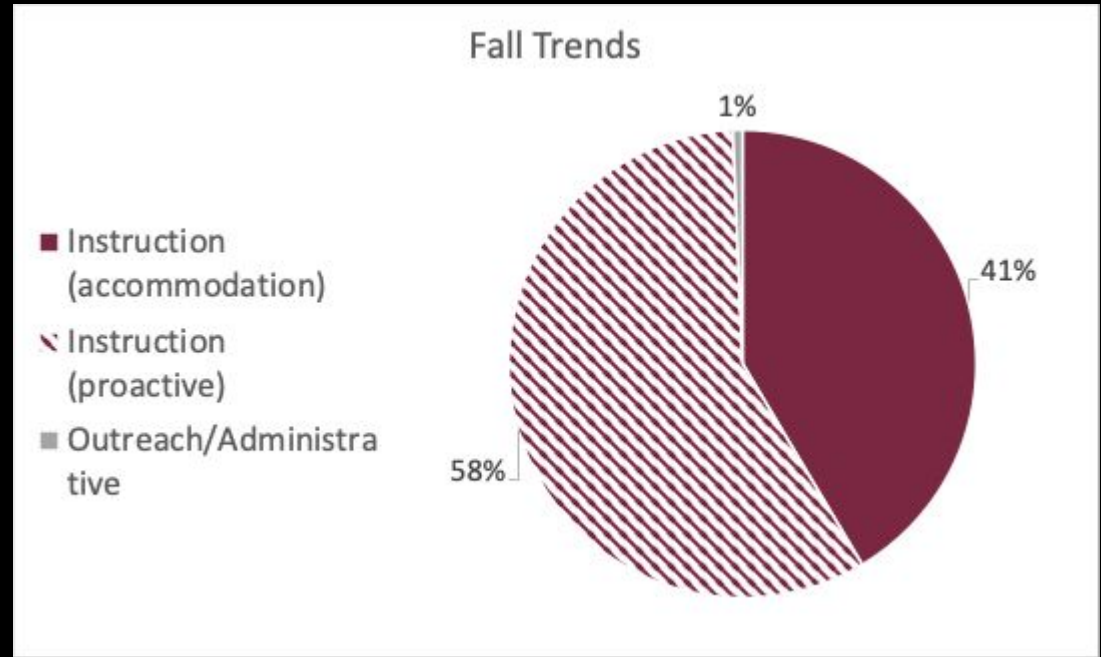

Live Captioning





Live Captioning - What is it?

- Live captioning describes both machine-generated and human-transcribed text provided in real time.
- Made available to the audience through a CC button **within a video player** or **via a separate browser window**.

Live Captioning - when?

1. Accommodations for any event
2. Public events
3. Internal facing (VT-only) public events



Live Captioning - How?

- Professional live captions - requestable service
 - ~\$1/min (centralized & non-centralized)
- Machine (AI) captions (e.g. webcaptioner.com)
 - Free service, less accurate

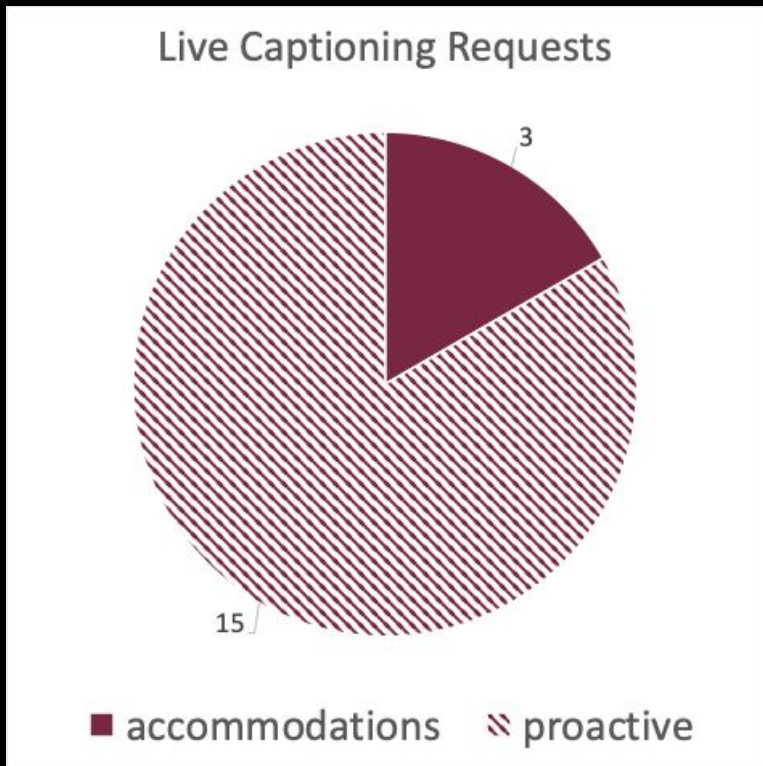
