Brief Update on the Unified Endpoint Management Project

- Jamf (Apple device mgmt.) available since July 1, 2020
- Intune (Windows, Android, etc. device mgmt.) implementation is delayed
 - Delayed due to a group mgmt. issue and permissions
 - We believe that issue may be resolved as of this week, and we are proceeding with scenario testing
 - We plan to announce general availability of Intune via TechSupport and a Campus Notice in VTx
 - If the project does not encounter further issues, we plan to give a full presentation at Spring (2022) DCSS
