Email and calendar service decision

- All employees and students will move to Exchange Online for email and calendars
- Virginia Tech will be migrated to Exchange Online by April 2024
- Visit the <u>Google and Microsoft Service Changes at</u> <u>Virginia Tech</u> website for additional details

How does the migration work?

\circ Pre-staging

- 95% of your data (email, calendar, & contacts) will be copied from Google to Microsoft 365 Exchange Online
- Messages stored in your Gmail trash will not be migrated
- Employees and students using Google today will continue to work in Google during pre-staging
- Final Cutover At pre-scheduled dates,
 - the remaining 5% of data is copied to Exchange Online and groups of users will begin working in Exchange Online
 - the Gmail and Google calendar services for these users will be disabled
 - the Google data will be held for 15 days after the cutover to ensure no issues are found

When will my migration take place?

- **Students** the entire population is moving at the same time
 - Pre-staging: 11/27/2023 to 01/07/2024
 - Final Cutover: 01/08/2024 to 01/15/2024

Employees

- Employees will be moving in 6 different groups
- All employees in the same OU will be cutover to Exchange Online on the same date
- Pre-staging dates for employees will vary based on mail sizes, i.e., we must start the migration on large mailboxes earlier than smaller ones
- On 12/01/2023, a schedule of the migrations by OU will be available on the project website
- The MyCAT app will also be updated on 12/01/2023 to show users their assigned pre-stage and cutover dates. The app will also provide status updates to let you know how your migration is progressing.

What if I am already using Exchange Online and do not need any data to be copied from my Google account?

- Employees have the option to decline migration support
- Between 11/27/2023 and 12/15/2023, employees will be able to use <u>MyCAT</u> to decline migration support
- $\,\circ\,$ If you decide to decline migration support,
 - no Google data will be copied to Exchange Online for your account
 - your Gmail service will still end on the cutover date assigned to your OU
- OU Admins: Available now! OU Admins have the ability using the <u>CAT</u> app to set the migration support option on behalf of employees in their OUs until 11/26/2023

Google Storage and Data Removal

What is happening with Google My Drives?

- Google My Drive will remain available as a service for employees and students
- On 01/16/2024, student Google accounts will receive a 5 GB storage limit. Students above 5 GB will go read-only.
- On 03/15/2024, employee Google accounts will receive a storage limit from 5 GB (minimum) to an amount set by their departments. Employees above their department assigned storage limit will go read-only.
- **OU Admins:** Tools are available in <u>CAT</u> today for you to set the storage limits for employees in your OUs

Google Storage and Data Removal

Only 29% of employee managed Google Shared Drives have been claimed by departments.

What is happening with Google Shared Drives?

- Google Shared Drives will remain available as a service for employees
- Shared Drives can be created with department approval and students can be invited as collaborators
- On 02/15/2024, any Shared Drives that have not been claimed by a department will be set to a 0 GB storage limit and go readonly
- On 03/15/2024, department Shared Drives will be set to storage limit determined by the departments. Drives above this limit will go read-only
- Employees can recommend which Shared Drives should be kept and see the claim status of each drive using the <u>MyCAT</u> app
- **OU Admins:** Tools are available in <u>CAT</u> today for OU Admins to set the storage limits for department Shared Drives

Google Storage and Data Removal

When will data be deleted for Google Shared Drives?

- For Google Shared Drives, data will be deleted in the following order
 - 03/2024: Drives managed by alumni or users with no active VT relationship and who have never worked for the university
 - $\circ~$ 04/2024: Drives managed by students and affiliates who have never worked for the university
 - 05/2024: Drives that have not been claimed by departments including drives managed by former employees or former student workers
 - $\circ~$ 06/2024: CCS will work with departments to address any use cases where Shared Drives are exceeding assigned storage limits
 - $\circ~$ **OU Admins:** Use <u>CAT</u> to identify a plan for your department's Google Shared Drives

Google Photos Service End Date

Google Photos Service End Date

16% of employees still have data in Google Photos.

When will Google Photos be turned off at Virginia Tech?

- 01/16/2024, Google Photos will be ending as a service at Virginia Tech
- All users should use <u>Google Takeout</u> to remove all data from this service prior to the service end date
- All users should make sure no app on their mobile devices is still syncing photo data with their VT Google accounts
- Data left in the service will continue to count against your storage, but you will no longer be able to access the app
- <u>Check your storage</u> to make sure you have 0 bytes in Google Photos
