



Future of ERP Working Group - Charge



The **Future of ERP Working Group** - an ad-hoc sub-committee of the IT Governance Administrative Technology Committee. Began meeting in November 2022. Functional and Technical membership.

The charge to the **Future of ERP Working Group**:

- Assess the marketplace for ERP administrative applications
- Assess the functional and technical effectiveness of Virginia Tech's ERP
- Submit recommendations for the future of Virginia Tech's ERP administrative applications

Management of Banner 2023-24 Guiding Principles



March 2023 - Spring 2024

- Study ERP marketplace and work with Tambellini to better understand offerings – include Banner and other marketplace options for institutions comparable to VT
- Adopt the cloud-centric philosophy outlined on the upcoming slide and begin work on moving our Banner ERP to this architecture
- Engage with Ellucian to assist with the Banner 9 migration and create solutions that meet VT needs first in Managed Cloud and in the future potentially SaaS
- Create and begin execution of a project plan for Banner 9 under the cloudcentric philosophy
- Prioritize the Banner 9/cloud-centric work over other projects that can be delayed, cancelled or postponed


Cloud-centric Philosophy for Banner Management 2023-24



- Optimize usage of baseline functionality of vendor applications
- Address processes for specific institutional needs with goals to avoid future rework and use software configuration, where possible
- Review policies and procedures that require ERP functionality outside of those delivered through baseline to determine if they can be adjusted and/or eliminated or if external outsourcing and/or development will be needed to accomplish in the future
- Promoting modern user-centric engagement for front-facing services and automation/integrations/standards for back-end processing
- Implementing and managing integrations using API-centric technology and industry standards, where possible
- Eliminating direct database interactions (for integrations, institutional mods, etc.),
 where possible
