

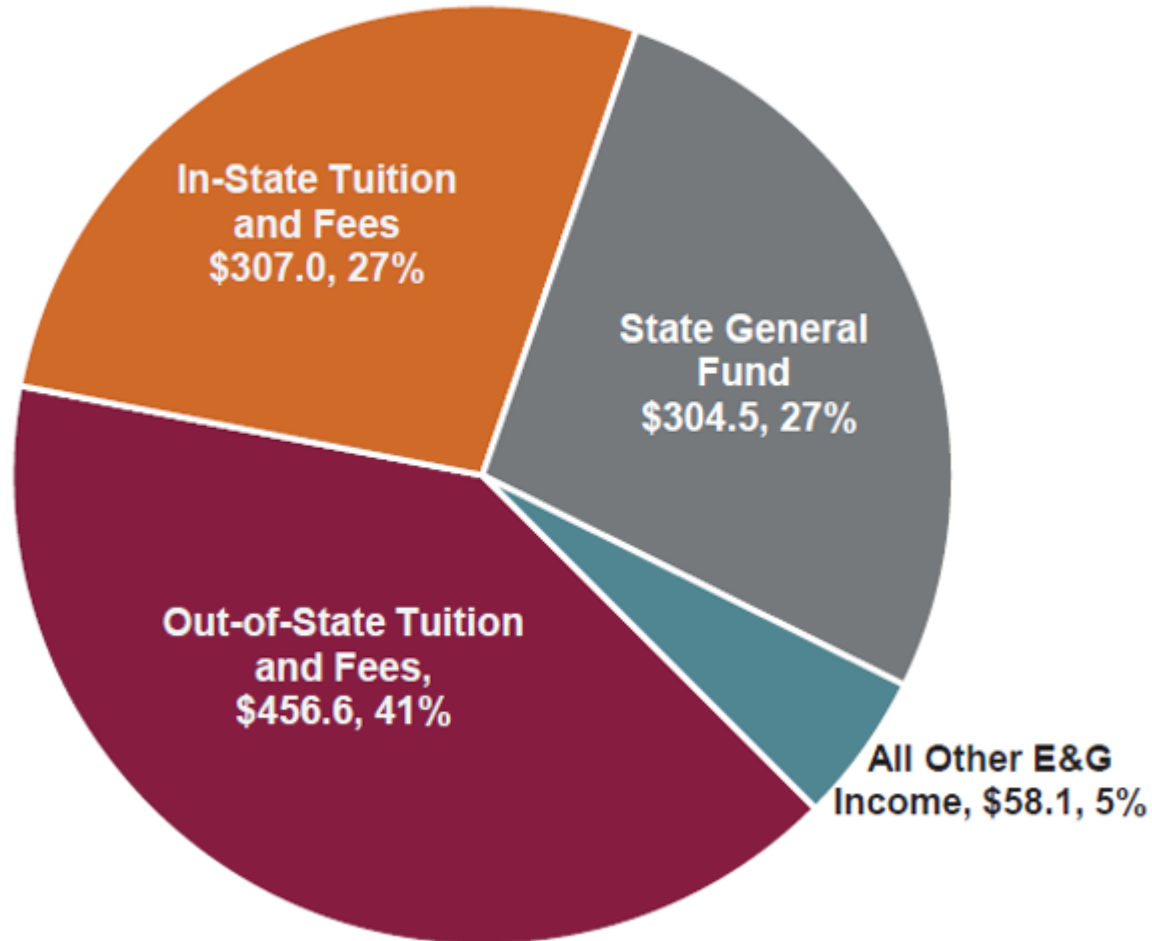

FY26 E&G Revenue by Major Source *University Division*



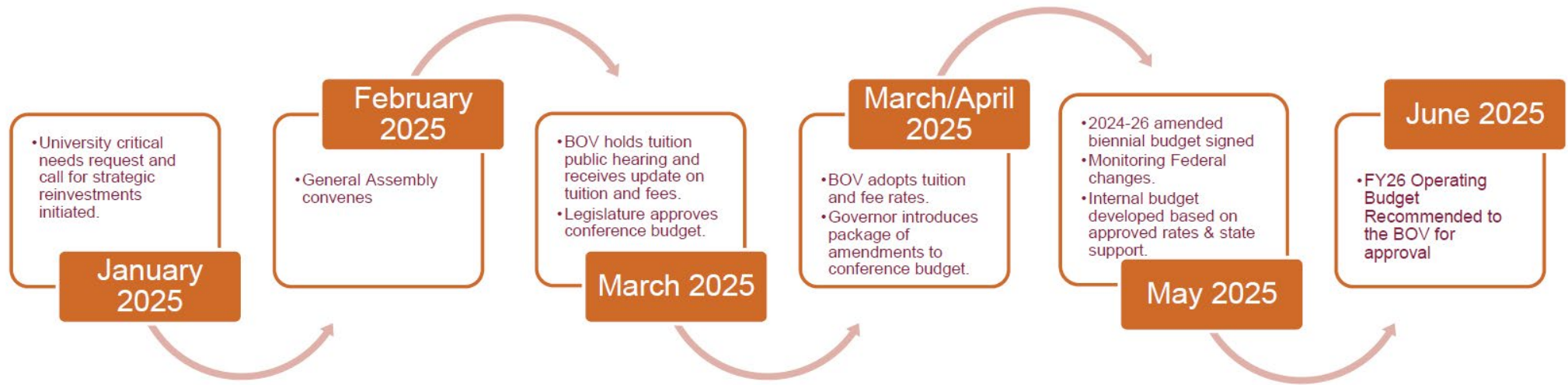

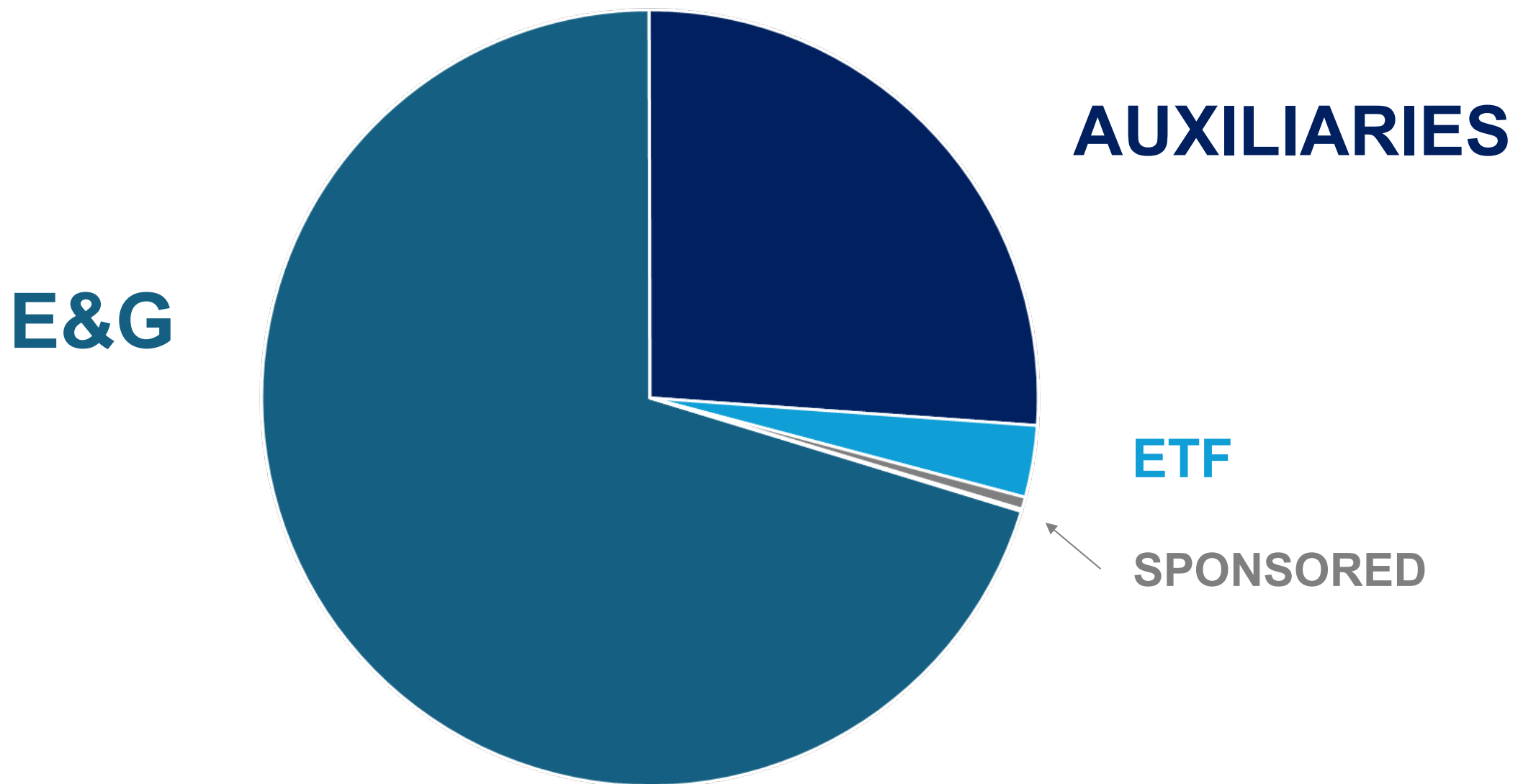
FY2024

- Forecast to be over budget \$2.75M - \$4.75M
- Previous CIO left - Sharon Pitt started February 2024
- Previous Finance Director left - Lynne Caver started May 2024
- Slowed some hiring and some purchases
- Many purchases were pushed into FY25
- Completed FY2024 with zero shortfall

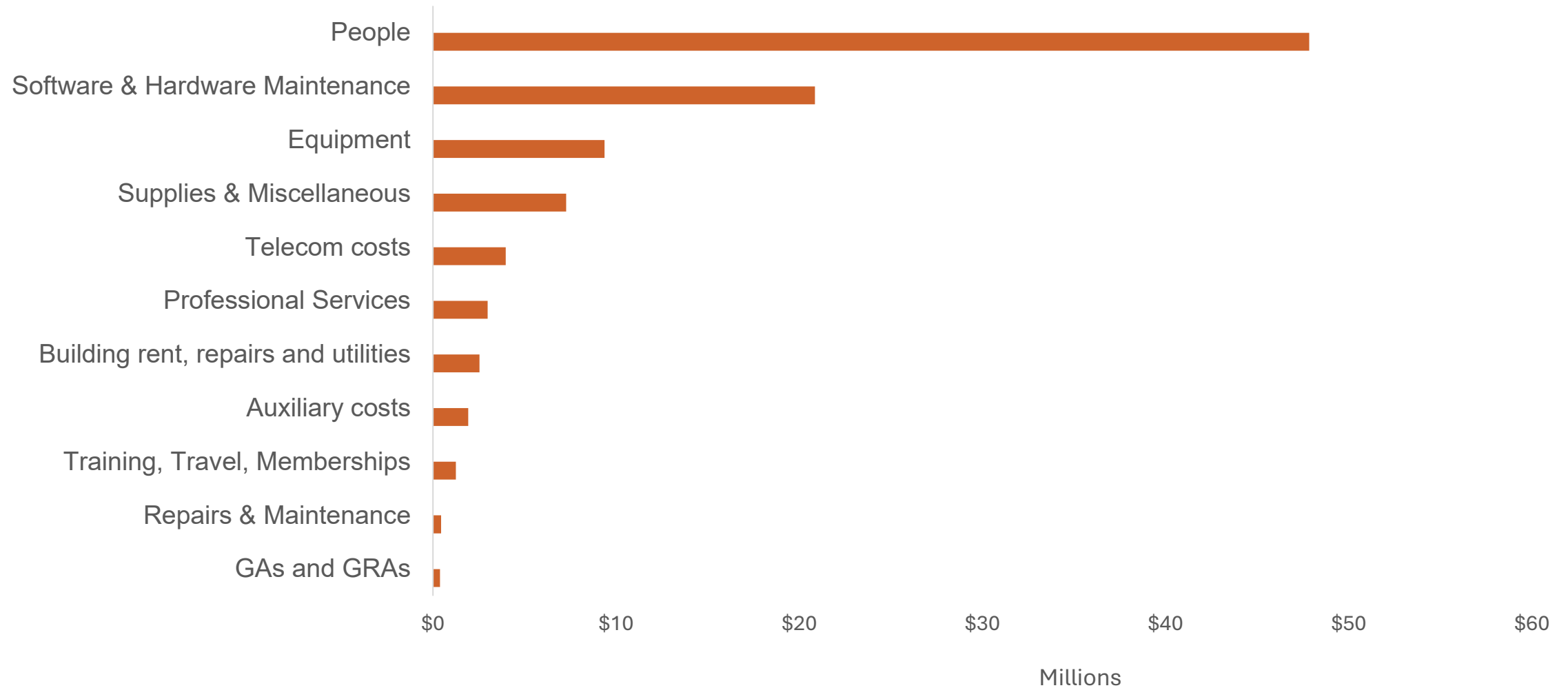
FY2025

- Successfully completed the year on budget
- CNR funding received for initiatives:
 - Active Directory Security Upgrade
 - Software Escalation
 - ERP
- Received some funding (one-time and base) that eased the shortfall and enabled us to drive some initiatives forward
- Used funds to fill in the gaps and to position us well for FY26

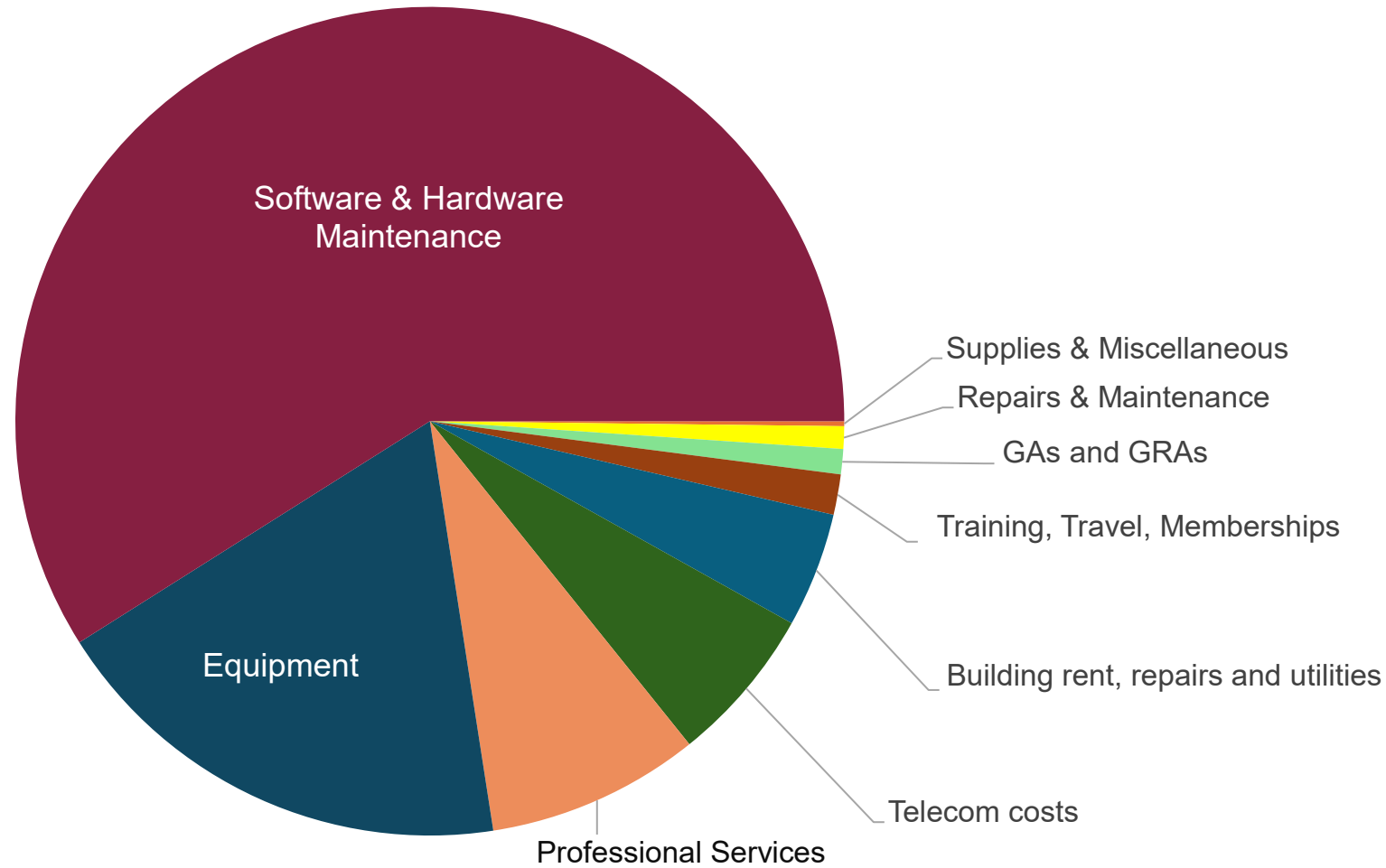
FY25 DoIT SPEND BY SOURCE
