  - One-Time Funding


ETF – Equipment Trust Fund – state allocation for equipment

#### FY2024

- Forecast to be over budget \$2.75M \$4.75M
- Previous CIO left Sharon Pitt started February 2024
- Previous Finance Director left Lynne Caver started May 2024
- Slowed some hiring and some purchases
- Many purchases were pushed into FY25
- Completed FY2024 with zero shortfall

### **DolT Budget**




#### FY2025

- Used funds to fill in the gaps and to position us well for FY26


#### **FY25 DoIT SPEND BY SOURCE**






#### FY25 SPEND – ALL SOURCES
