

 - Supporting Advancement's march to \$300 M / yr and reviewing Blackbaud cloud
 - Migration to Platform Analytics and expansion of CMDB population
 - GIS ETL Workflow, Archival Repository, and Emergency Management Tool
 - Archiving Canvas courses
 - Supporting migration to IT Common Platform and assisting other teams
 - Wrapping up transition from TimeClock Plus to Banner Time Entry
